Who We're Looking For

The SAT Mathematics Instructor will teach SAT-related math problem-solving skills to junior scholars preparing to take the SAT in June 2021. Our ideal candidate has standardized testing instruction experience and/or experience teaching mathematics skills to high school-aged students (Algebra, Geometry, Trigonometry).

Specific Qualifications

- Strong math standardized testing ability and enthusiasm for teaching to the SAT exam; self-reported SAT I, SAT II, or GRE math scores may be requested (required).
- Understanding of standardized test-taking strategies (required).
- Minimum one-year classroom-based teaching or small-group instruction experience with adolescents and/or high school students, preferably from low-income background (required).
- Well-developed knowledge on how to differentiate a classroom and meet the needs of scholars with a wide range of foundational skills (highly preferred).
